## Section I

## **General Terms and Conditions**

The below conditions (statutory basis for charges) and definitions shall form an integral part of the Port, Marine and Cargo Tariff for the RAK Ports Group. All activities undertaken and services provided by the ports, and charging provisions are in accordance with applicable regulations and shall continue to apply except were varied from time to time by the Port Management. Full details of the General Terms and Conditions can be located at www.rakports.ae.

### **Statutory basis of charge**

#### THE PORT TO RAISE CHARGES

The port to charge "ship, passenger, cargo and other dues" as considered "fit" is vested in the board of RAK Ports by the Ras Al Khaimah (RAK) Ports Act No. 9 of 2008.

### THE POWER TO COLLECT CHARGES RAISED

By virtue of the RAK Ports Act No. (9) of 2008 the RAK Ports may recover rates payable to them in respect of a ship by distraint and sale of the ship and its tackle and in respect of any goods by distraint and sale either of those goods or any other goods held on Port premises belonging to the persons liable for payment of the dues.

### **PAYMENT TERMS**

Payment due within 30 days of the date of demand/invoice unless otherwise indicated. Thereafter interest will be charged at 4.5% per month PRO-RATA. RAK Ports reserves the right to demand full payment prior to departure.

### **CHANGES TO TARIFF**

RAK Ports reserve the right to alter/modify the above tariff giving a notice period of 7 days only.

### **VALUE ADDED TAX**

All rates and charges contained within this tariff and any additional charges made by the Port are listed exclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT). VAT will be added as per the Federal Decree-Law No (8) of 2017 on Value Added Tax, and under the associated Executive Regulations, as applicable.

### **CURRENT EDITION AND VALIDITY:**

This Tariff edition is a new version which replaces and updates all previous individual Port Tariffs and will apply from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

# Section II



### **Definitions (Cargo)**

**AVERAGE LOAD/DISCHARGE RATE:** Calculated from the time cargo loading/ discharge operations commence to the time cargo operations cease divided by the amount of cargo loaded.

**CARGO CHARGES: CONSOLIDATED RATE:** Rate per ton for the loading or discharging of commodities listed in <u>Cargo charges – Consolidated rate</u> which is inclusive of the following equipment and services:

- Initial and final draft survey.
- Loading of trucks used for cargo movement from stockyard to berth (Export).
- Shovels used for pushing on the berth (up to 4 hrs before berthing only).
- Charges for MHC loading (excludes any crane delays).
- Berth cleaning and Deflectors.
- Forklift (for deflector placement).
- Operations staff overtime.
- Truck access and egress charges.
- Loading of trucks for cargo movement from berth to customers site (Imports).

### **Excluded costs are typically:**

- Loading/discharge delays.
- Hatch cleaning.
- Trucking cost from stockyard to berth/from quarry to port.
- Storage area charge.
- Shovel used for loading from stockyard to customer site (Imports).
- Marine charges.
- Cargo lashing.
- Mobile dock loaders.
- Cargo returned from berth to stockyard.
- Shovels used for stockyard management/Cargo Ramping.
- Intermediate draft surveys.

The above list is not exhaustive and is provided for indication purposes only, excluded items are at the sole discretion of the Port Managers.

**CARGO CHARGES: NON-CONSOLIDATED RATE:** The non-consolidated rate will apply in circumstances where the consolidated rate cannot be applied and will exclude any port equipment, services, stevedoring and overtime etc.

**CHARGES PER HOUR OR PART THEREOF:** defined as follows - if services are used for 1 hour and 15 minutes, the charge levied will be for 2.0 hours.

**CURRENCY:** All charges and rates mentioned in this schedule of charges are payable in United Arab Emirates Dirhams.

**DAY:** A calendar day consisting of 24 continuous hours commencing at midnight.

**FREE FLOWING CARGO:** For bulk solid products, those that do not exceed their angle of repose during discharge operations.

**FREIGHT TON (FRT):** Assessed by a weight of tonne, 1,000 kilo's or a measure of one cubic metre, whichever is greater.

**GROSS TONNAGE (GT):** (GT) of a vessel as recorded in the valid National or International Tonnage Certificate, issued by a vessel's national administration or classification society on behalf of the national administration. Where a vessel or craft has a dual GT, then the higher figure applies.

POA: Price on Application.

**PORT DEVELOPMENT CHARGE**: A charge levied by the Port Authority contributing towards the investment in new technology and efficiency improvement related infrastructure.

PTPD: Per Ton Per Day.

**RAK PORTS:** RAK Ports is a collective name for a multi-purpose port network, comprising of Saqr Port, RAK Maritime City FZA, Ras Al Khaimah Port, Al Jazeera Port and Al Jeer Port. The port areas include the waters within the port limits and anchorages as detailed in Law 10 of 2017 amending Law 9 of 2008 concerning RAK Ports.

**STEVEDORING SERVICES**: All Stevedoring services are to be booked and provided through the Cargo Department. No third-party stevedoring services allowed, unless agreed by Port Management.

**'STICKY' CARGO:** For bulk solid products, classed as those products that exceed their angle of repose during discharge operations or cargo that by virtue of consistency reduces the discharge rates normally achievable. A product may be classified as sticky cargo by the Port Management whose decision is final.

**STOCK YARDS**: All stockyards are located within the Ports ISPS "Restricted" Boundary, with access & egress through Port Security controlled gates. Stock Yards/Facilities utilised and located outside the Port Facility boundary (for Import Cargo), will require Customs clearance/approvals prior to vessel discharge and cargo exit.

**STORAGE CHARGES:** Storage of all cargos in stock yards and or warehouses will be on a square metre (m<sup>2</sup>) basis.

**TRANSSHIPMENT:** "Transshipment Cargo means goods landed from a Vessel and placed in the custody of the Port Operator for the purpose of shipment on another Vessel. To qualify for the transshipment Cargo rates the Cargo must be discharged by the first

carrier onto the Port Operator terminals and remain in the custody of the Port Operator until it is transshipped on-board the on carrying Vessel at the Port Operator terminals.

**TRANSSHIPMENT HANDLING CHARGES:** Transshipment Cargo that complies with the above definition shall be charged - 1 Port Handling Charge and 2 Stevedoring Charges. Where the on-carrying Vessel is berthed at a berth other than that at which the transshipment Cargo was landed, then any additional costs involved in moving the Cargo will be paid in addition.

**VESSEL:** means barges, boats, tugs, launches or any other mechanised or non-mechanised floating craft.

### **CARGO HANDLING AND OTHER CHARGES**

Vessels calling at RAK Ports will be charged as follows:

### 1. Cargo charges - Consolidated rate

### 2. Cargo charges: Non-consolidated (Break-Bulk)

The non-consolidated rate will apply in circumstances where the consolidated rate cannot be applied. Typically, when:

The use of Port Equipment is not required.

The above is for indication only and goods or commodities included will be at the sole discretion of the RAK Ports Management.

### **PORT HANDLING CHARGE:**

This includes handling and movement of Cargo from the hook of the Vessel up to presentation to Consignee's transport and vice versa. Transportation of the cargo is to be arranged by the consignee/vessel agent. Should any other port equipment or services be used MHC, Forklifts, they will be billed as per tariff.

- Special rates apply for the use of the Mobile Cranes outside the port area and are subject to additional charges at the discretion of and on application to the Port Manager.
- A Cargo Declaration Form must be completed by the ship's agent or the consignee of the cargo or agent thereof and submitted to the Port no later than 24 hours after completion of discharge and/or loading.
- Declarations of catch values for fish, shellfish and other sea-caught foodstuffs should be accompanied by a landing certificate clearly detailing the market value.

### **Definitions (Marine)**

**AGENT:** Any individual, person, firm, or company who registered with the port in accordance with port requirements and engaged in and/or responsible for the handling of a vessel call.

**ANCHORAGE CHARGES:** The anchorage charges shall apply to vessels using the anchorage zones based on the vessel's gross tonnage, per day or part thereof. Vessel using the anchorage area and subsequently berthing in the ports are exempted from the anchorage charges.

**BERTH:** The water area at edge of quay/wharf, including mooring facilities, used by a vessel calling RAK Ports for loading discharging of cargo, lay-by or other purposes.

**CHARGES PER HOUR OR PART THEREOF:** Defined as follows - if services are used for 1 hour and 15 minutes, the charge levied will be for 2.0 hours.

**COLD MOVE:** Vessels that are required to be moved without the power of engine/steering gear or due to damage shall be considered a cold move.

**COMBINATION:** A sea-going tug and barge, whereby the barge has no propulsion and is either towed or pushed by an accompanying tug.

**CONSERVANCY:** Vessels, 500GT and above, entering the limits of RAK Ports regardless of whether they eventually berth at a port will be charged Conservancy. The charges include a stay at anchorage for a period not exceeding 14 days. This charge covers Tower Operations, channel maintenance, aids to navigation, documentation, channel survey and other general marine matters as decided by the Harbour Master.

**CONSOLIDATED RATE:** Inclusive of Towage, Pilotage\*, Pilot vessel, Conservancy and Mooring for one inward and one outward movement and applies to all ships, excluding barges, calling at RAK Ports (excludes Tenants' berths) into a single charge for Marine Services

\* Vessels with PEC will have pilotage reduction and appropriate PEC charge applied.

**CURRENCY:** All charges and rates mentioned in this schedule of charges are payable in United Arab Emirates Dirhams.

**DAY:** A calendar day consisting of 24 continuous hours commencing at midnight.

**DETENTION:** Detention charges shall be levied if a vessel is not ready to move when required.

**DYNAMIC UKC (DUKC):** UKC denotes Under Keel Clearance, which is the minimum depth of water required under a ship's keel to ensure that it doesn't touch bottom. DYNAMIC implies a system involving real-time calculation of this minimum depth.

**GROSS TONNAGE (GT):** GT of a vessel as recorded in the valid National or International Tonnage Certificate, issued by a vessel's national administration or classification society on behalf of the national administration. Where a vessel or craft has a dual GT, then the higher figure applies.

**HARBOUR DUES:** Dues will be levied on all vessels entering the port. The charge is based on the vessel's gross tonnage (GT). Harbour dues pay for the upkeep and maintenance of the port marine infrastructure.

**HARBOUR MASTER:** The Group Harbour Master is designated by RAK Ports Executive Management/Board and head of the Marine department. The Harbour Master has day-to-day responsibility for managing the safe operation of navigation and other marine activities in the harbour and its approaches. The post holder must be competent and a suitably qualified person with sufficient experience for the role.

**LAY-BY AT BERTH**: Vessels/combination requesting a Port berth for purposes other than working cargo.

**LIGHTER:** An open or covered barge equipped with crane and towed by a tugboat.

LOA: Length Overall.

**MARINE SERVICES:** Any marine service or operation of whatsoever nature provided or executed by the port (e.g., pilotage, towage, mooring etc.) in order to facilitate arrival, shifting or departure of vessels.

**MOORING GANG:** A group of trained marine employees who fasten or release and cast off the ships mooring ropes on/off the berth bollards, following the sequence and instructions issued by the pilot/vessel master or PEC holder.

**NAVY VESSELS and WARSHIPS:** A Seagoing Vessel deployed on behalf of the United Arab Emirates Navy or the navy of a foreign power, commanded by a naval officer and fully or partially manned by military personnel (Will only be dealt with on a case-by-case basis).

**NON-CONSOLIDATED RATE:** The non-consolidated rate will apply in certain circumstances where the consolidated rate cannot apply (see Annex Two).

**PEC (PILOTAGE EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE):** Means a certificate issued by RAK Ports to a bona fide Master or First Mate of a ship, exempting a vessel from compulsory pilotage when personally navigated by that master/first mate.

**PILOTAGE SERVICE:** The act carried out by a competent pilot, of assisting the master of a ship in navigation and manoeuvring when entering, leaving or shifting in a port or the approaches. All vessels, other than exempted vessels, navigating whether by entry, leaving or shifting within the Port shall be under the charge of a Pilot or PEC Holder, as per RAK Ports Pilotage Directions.

**PILOT VESEL:** The Pilot Vessel is used for embarking/disembarking of the pilot to and from the vessel.

**RAK PORTS:** RAK Ports is a collective name for a multi-purpose port network, comprising of Saqr Port, RAK Maritime City FZA, Ras Al Khaimah Port, Al Jazeera Port and Al Jeer Port. The port areas include the waters within the port limits and anchorages as detailed in Law 10 of 2017 amending Law 9 of 2008 concerning RAK Ports.

**SUPPLY LAUNCH:** A vessel, less than 500gt, which operates on a regular basis from one of the RAK Ports and provides marine services at sea, such as supply boats and crew boats used for delivery of goods and provisions, transfer of crew and other personnel, and offshore services within the areas of port jurisdiction or UAE waters.

**Saqr Port Shifting:** Loaded vessels arriving with draft exceeding the depth for the Inner Harbour will be required to berth at the Deep-Water Terminal. Shifting to the Inner Harbour may be required when draft permits, to free up the berths at the terminal, with cost of shift at vessel expense.

**SHIP:** Any vessel or containership, tanker, cruise-ship, car carrier, general/bulk cargo vessel, tug, barge, lighter, non-displacement craft or other vessel of any description.

**SHIP TO SHIP (STS) TRANSFER:** Refers to the transfer cargo between seagoing of ships positioned alongside each other, either while stationary or underway.

**TOWING:** Towing is defined as any activity regarding the holding, pulling, pushing or otherwise moving a vessel by another vessel, if needed.

**VESSEL:** Means barges, boats, tugs, launches, or any other mechanised or non-mechanised floating craft.

**VESSEL IN DISTRESS OR DISABLED VESSELS:** Vessels that are unable to sail effectively or in a seaworthy state as a result of engine trouble, lack of officers or crew, damage to the hull or ship's gear (will be handled with on a case by case basis).

**VTS Surcharge:** A fee applicable for the establishment of a state-of-the-art IALA Compliant Vessel Traffic Service (VTS).

- Each additional timing after the first hour, shall be rounding to its next complete hour.
- Towage charges for tankers, gas carriers of more than 20,000 GT and other vessels calling to load and or discharge hazardous and obnoxious goods (these kinds of goods are categorised as per the IMDG Code of the IMO) will be charged AED 9,980.00 per hour per tug.

In circumstances a tug is despatched to another port away from its base port the charge will generally apply from passing Fairway Buoy inbound to passing Fairway Buoy outbound. The Port shall not be responsible to the hirer for any loss or damage or injury to life or property arising directly or indirectly from the use of the tugs or delay in supply of the tugs or due to the failure of the tugs at any stage during the period of hire. The hirer shall indemnify the Port against all loss or damage or injury to life arising directly or indirectly from the use of the tugs during the period of the supply on hire to any property belonging to the port including the tugs or to any other person or property.

- 1. Bunker Vessels <u>will be allowed</u> to supply bunkers to vessel's **alongside** in RAK Ports during cargo operations, **or at anchorage**.
- 2. Approval of the operator will be subject to Marine and HSE approval of Risk assessment and Oil Spill Management Plan.
- 3. License fees for Bunker operator will be **56,000 AED** per annum.
- 4. Tariff for bunker supply in port will be as follows:
  - a. The Port charge **per Vessel per 48-hour period** or part thereof is levied for Port services, as hereinafter itemized. **The charge will be AED 2.95 per Gross Ton.** 
    - i. The services of a pilot and pilot launch for the inward transit of the channel from sea and berthing.
    - ii. The services of a pilot and pilot launch for un-berthing from the berth for the outward
    - iii. Transit of the channel to sea or to another berth.
    - iv. Up to two Port tugs for the operations described in (i) and (ii) above. Where additional tugs are utilised they shall be charged as per our Marine Tariff.
    - v. The availability of all other Port facilities such as navigable channels, tidal, meteorological, and navigational data.
    - vi. The availability of Port Facility emergency and oil pollution equipment.
    - vii. Charges to be applied per bunker operation. Therefore, if two vessels are supplied the charge is to be counted as two visits.
    - viii. The first 48 hour period will commence at the time of first line on the jetty/ vessel. The total visit time will end when the last line is let go.
      - ix. Only Conservancy Charge as per Tariff, will be applicable for **Bunker Supply at Anchor.**
  - b. Approval of the operator will be at the sole discretion of RAK Ports Management subject to successful demonstration of safety and emergency response procedures.
